

Sen. Stabenow Manufacturing Bill Would Boost Biobased

In November U.S. Senator Debbie Stabenow (D-MI) introduced the "Manufacturing Jobs for America" initiative aimed at creating jobs and training workers in advanced manufacturing. The initiative includes three proposals authored by Sen. Stabenow:

- Bring Jobs Home Act, introduced last year, ends a tax loophole for corporations that send jobs overseas and cuts taxes for businesses that move jobs and business activity to America from another country.
- New Skills for New Jobs Act that builds on successful efforts in Michigan and other states that are helping community colleges partner with local businesses to provide training to workers to new high-skilled jobs.
- Make It in America (48C) tax credit, to provide businesses with up to a 30 percent tax cut to produce clean energy technologies such as solar panels, wind turbines, advanced batteries and biobased products manufactured here at home.
